## Community Businesses Pledge More Than \$100,000 in Support of Affordable Housing for Bala Families

Twelve Muskoka Lakes businesses unite to donate Gift-In-Kind to Habitat for Humanity

The business community in Muskoka Lakes has generously come together to pledge \$115,343 of Gift-in-Kind donations, in support of the OGN's affordable semi-detached homes, for Habitat's build project at 1016 Elm Street in Bala. These energy-efficient, universally accessible units that will become home to two area families, is set to be completed by Christmas of this year.

"Seeing these businesses come together in partnership is the true spirit of Community," says OGN CEO Kimberley Woodcock, "Twelve local companies have donated critical services and products – everything from grading, excavation, and transportation to framing,
